## FACTORS TO BE CONSIDERED IN THE FORM, AMOUNT AND DURATION OF ALIMONY PURSUANT TO M.G.L. ch. 208 section 53

- 1. Length of marriage;
- 2. Age of the parties;
- 3. Health of the parties;
- 4. Income;
- 5. Employment;
- 6. Employability of both parties, including employability through reasonable diligence and additional training, if necessary;
- 7. Economic and non-economic contribution of both parties to the marriage;
- 8. Marital lifestyle;
- 9. Ability of each party to maintain the marital lifestyle;
- 10.Lost economic opportunity as a result of the
  marriage;
- 11. And such other factors as the Court considers relevant and material.
